VOLCANIC BROWN MISSING IN MOUNTAINS

Following the departure of a search party last week to seek R.A. "Volcanic" Brown, aged prospector of Grand Forks, in the Pitt Lake district, possible word is expected within the next week of its success.

Brown was last seen on August 17 by a fellow prospector who was on his way out of the mountainous district north of Pitt Lake.

The search party sent in by the provincial police authorities is headed by Game Warden G.C. Stevenson and Provincial Constable E. Murphy of Vancouver. Reaching Alvin at the head of Pitt Lake by boat, they have at least a twenty-five-mile trek through the mountains to where Brown is reported to have a cabin. It was in this vicinity where the prospector was lost six years ago and finally located by a search party.
