“VOLCANO” [sic] BROWN MISSING IN HILLS

New Westminster November 3—Plans are being made to search for R.A. Brown, 86-year-old prospector who has been in the wilds since August. He is believed to be somewhere in the mountains between Pitt and Harrison Lakes.

He was on his way into that section when last seen and had, it is said, food calculated to last till September 15.

The aged prospector was also lost about six years ago and when discovered was found to have amputated with his jack-knife one of his own toes which had been frostbitten.

Constable Stevenson of the Game Conservation Board and Provincial Constable Murphy are organizing the party which may leave New Westminster tomorrow, under instruction from Staff Sergeant J. Kier, provincial police.

Brown claims to have discovered traces of an aluminum deposit.
