HOPE ABANDONED FOR 3 IN BLIZZARD

All hope for the safety of two men and one woman, lost in the timbered mountainous country north and east of here [Vancouver] was abandoned by searchers tonight.

The missing woman is Miss Mary Warburton, 60-year-old nurse, unreported since she set out on foot over a mountain trail from Squamish at the head of How Sound to Indian river.

J.A (Volcanic) Brown. 80-year-old prospector, was last seen in August when he started out from his camp at the head of Pitt Lake, east of Vancouver, for the headwaters of the Upper Stave river on a prospecting trip.

Oscar Sneeve, of Mission City, has been missing since he left on a deer-hunting expedition several days ago.

Snow has fallen for 16 days in the search area.
