prisoner in the Provincial  
Gaol aforesaid under sentence  
of death, "for the Murder of  
one Lonce Bee".

On the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January in  
the year aforesaid at the Pro-  
vincial Gaol aforesaid by  
homicide in the execution  
of the law by hanging and  
not otherwise, did die.
